Ellen's husband Chauncey died four years later, in 1892. Note (above left), Chauncey's final address (803 7th St) from Forest Lawn is the same as item 8 on the death certificate (next page) for Nellie Joslyn. This is also the address shown as the location of Chauncey's death on his (Ellen's) date of death on the death certificate is

Emily Ada Joslyn listed her mother's date of death as 9-24-1887 on her DAR application. The year is wrong, but the 9-24 agrees with the death certificate. Helen is usually Ellen on other sources.

The youngest daughter, Elizabeth Joslyn, died in 1909 at age 25. Note that her obituary lists her parents as Chauncey and **Ellen** Joslyn (not Helen).

Here is the Death Certificate of Nellie Joslyn, wife of Chauncey Joslyn. Most evidence indicates she was born in Canada. The place of death (item 8) matches Chauncey's last address when he died in 1892 (see Forest Lawn previous page). Her name is most often found listed as Ellen C or Ellen, not Helen. In 1870, she was listed as Nellie on the US census.
