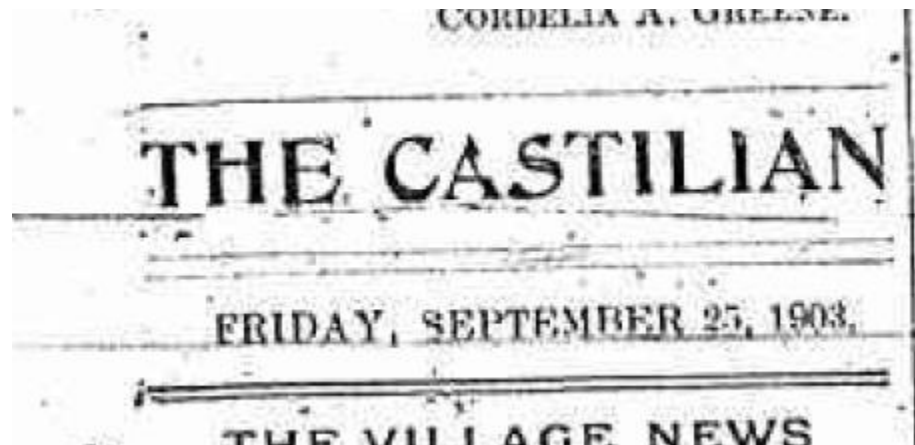


Laura O Joslyn Dunning – Obituary

—Mrs. Laura O. Dunning died at her home in Gainesville Friday, Sept. 18. She had been in her usual good health up to Friday morning, when she was taken suddenly ill and expired in the evening. Mrs. Dunning was the daughter of Alvin and Jerusha Joslin, and was born in the town of Gainesville, November 6, 1825. When 4 years old her parents removed to Warsaw, and latter to Buffalo. She was married to Michael Dunning in 1852 and they have resided for over forty years in the house where she died. She was an active worker in all good causes, was a member of the W. C. T. U., also of the Political Equality Club. Besides her husband she leaves an adopted son.
